Travelling

From Lisbon airport to the hotel:

From Lisbon airport (<http://www.ana-aerportos.pt/ANA/Lisboa/HomePage.htm>) the best way is to take a taxi directly to the hotel. It should be around €10 (10 minutes). There are some possibilities by bus (see airport website), but the difference in price and ease may not be significant.

If you choose to take a taxi from the airport to the hotel, you can buy a **Taxi Voucher**, which should be around €15.

Accommodation and Meeting Location

The stay has been arranged at the Hotel Tivoli Tejo (www.tivolitejo.com), a modern four-star property overlooking the River Tagus, which is located in the renewed side of Lisbon - former Expo 98 site, and now one of Lisbon's major new residential and business neighbourhoods.

Tourism in Lisbon

Lisboa is a legendary city with over 20 centuries of History. The Alfama is one of the oldest quarters in Lisboa. Since it largely survived the earthquake of 1755, the area still retains much of its original layout. (<http://www.portugalvirtual.pt>).

The Parque das Nações already houses the new Lisbon International Exhibition Centre, the Pavilhão Atlântico (multipurpose events arena) and the impressive Vasco da Gama shopping centre. The hotel is 5 minutes from Lisbon airport and is literally a two minute walk from the magnificent Estação do Oriente, where trains, the subway, buses and taxis converge in a full public transport interface.
